DeKalb County Felony Mental Health Court What You Need to Know

DeKalb County Felony Mental Health Court (DCFMHC) is a two-year judicially supervised treatment alternative sentencing program designed to assist felony offenders who are diagnosed with a severe and persistent mental illness or co-occurring disorder. DCFMHC participants attend intensive outpatient group sessions, individual counseling sessions, submit to frequent and random drug screens, and receive judicial supervision through weekly court appearances. Participants also receive psychiatric services, medication management assistance, case management services, social and peer support.

DCFMHC is a collaborative effort between DeKalb County Superior Court, DeKalb County District Attorney's office, DeKalb County Public Defender's office, Court Administration, DeKalb County Police, Georgia Department of Community Supervision, and other Community Partners.
